How to Prepare for Advocacy Day

 - Let them know you're coming to the 2020 Session on Jan 22nd and would like to meet with them in the morning.
- 6) You can find <u>pictures of your legislators in the Virginia Redbook</u>, so you know who to be on the lookout for when you're on the way to appointments.
- Ask your families for any drawings or notes from children that you can take with you. You will leave these drawings with the Delegates and Senators as a reminder of the people our programs serve.
